

## END USER LICENSE AGREEMENT (EULA) VERSION 1.0

### 1) OWNERSHIP

1.1) This is an agreement between you, the licensee/user and the supplier, Tmi Juuso Salakka (referred to as "No Bad Type"). By downloading, or using the typeface software, you are bound by the terms of this agreement. In accepting the terms of this agreement, you acknowledge understanding and are complying with its terms. This license will nullify any past agreement between the licensee and No Bad Type.

1.2) Font (Typeface software) contains the designs embedded in the software. It is intellectual property of the supplier and protected by the copyright law.

1.3) You have acquired a licensed software that grants you a non-exclusive permission to use the font. No Bad Type reserves all other rights to the font and its components.

1.4) Any modifications to the software are prohibited without a written permission from No Bad Type. This includes any conversion of the file format or renaming the font.

### 2) LICENSING

2.1) There are two variant licenses available for each font, Desktop font and Web font. Desktop fonts, provided in OTF format, are optimised to be used in design of printed material. Web fonts, in WOFF, TTF and EOT formats are optimal for use in digital purposes.

2.2) The license grants you the right to use the purchased font in agreed number of devices and/or securely host the font on a website with specified number of monthly page views. If your usage exceeds these limitations you are required to purchase another license.

2.3) The desktop font software can be used simultaneously on agreed number of devices (specified on the purchasing process) within your organisation. You're allowed to store the font files in a local network. In doing so you take responsibility to ensure that the number of users will not exceed the agreement.

2.4) You are restricted to embed the font in a secure read-only file format for any third party with an access to the file. An exception being: You may provide a print or pre-press service with a copy of the font file to be used (in accordance with this agreement) in a specified design project for a defined time period.

2.5) The use of webfont software is limited to one (1) domain including its subdomains. The monthly page views agreed upon the purchase is defined by the ex-

pected traffic on the website. You are required to buy an additional license if the traffic exceeds the agreed amount. You have to provide statistics (screenshots) on request to prove that the conditions of the agreement are met.

2.6) Webfonts can be used through "self-hosting". This means you host the font files on servers under your control. We demand you to implement the software in CSS (Cascading Style Sheets) and not to expose the location of your hosted font files.

### 3) WARRANTY

3.1) Should the delivered font file be defected, Supplier warrants to help fix any issues with the font or its components. Failing to do so, user is entitled to cancel the purchase.

3.2) You are required to review the applicability of the font prior to purchase. Any insufficiency in the software is not an eligible reason for a refund.

3.3) The supplier is not responsible for any consequential damage caused by use of the software.

### 4) PAYMENT

4.1) The prices provided in [www.nobadtype.com](http://www.nobadtype.com) include the value added tax (VAT) of the product at the time of the purchase. In orders within the EU the VAT rate of Finland will apply. For orders outside the EU the VAT will be excluded from the price.

4.2) The final price, VAT and any additional costs will be presented before placing an order.

4.3) The products will only be delivered after the payment has been made according to the final price stated.

### 5) VALIDITY

5.1) Failure to conform with the terms of the EULA shall result in immediate termination of the agreement.

5.2) This Agreement is a subject to the laws and regulations of Finland.
